IGP Salento Bianco



The name 'Luna' (= moon) recalls the habit to drink this wine in a convivial mood, during the beautiful moonlit nights in Salento characterized with a starry clear sky. Each lunar phase is a magic moment of transition and the whole nature perceives this visceral force.

Grape varietals: White Malvasia and Chardonnay.

Vineyard: 4 ha – Leverano (LE).

Soil type: alluvial, mainly calcareous.

Growing system: cordon spur and Guyot.

Density: 5.000/5.700 plants per ha.

Production process: the grapes, harvested by hand, are cooled in cold storage rooms and selected on a sorting table. Stems are removed and the berries softly pressed. Fermentation, evolution and batonnage in French oak barriques and refinement in bottle.
