

CALAVENTO*IGP Salento Malvasia Bianca*

A local saying goes "Salento: sun, sea and wind". Indeed Calavento takes its name from one of the natural elements that contributes to the optimal growth and maturation of the grapes in our lands. The breeze coming from the sea makes Malvasia grapes rich of elegant perfumes and aromas.

Grape varieties: Malvasia bianca

Area of production: Leverano (LE)

Vineyard: Tucci 62Ha

Soil type: alluvial, medium consistency with calcareous areas

Growing system: cordon spur and Guyot

Density: 5.000/5.700 plants per Ha

Yield per Ha.: 8,00 T/Ha grapes

Production process: stems removal and soft pressing. Fermentation at controlled temperature in stainless steel tanks and maturation in epoxy resin-lined cement tanks.
