

MENDOLA*IGP Salento Fiano*

Mendola is a dialectal term meaning almond. Indeed, it was usual to find trees among the rows of the vineyards, like the almond tree, so that the farmers could rest under the shade of their fronds.

Grape varieties: Fiano

Area of production: Leverano (LE)

Vineyard: Felicetta ó 2,10Ha

Soil type: alluvial, medium consistency with calcareous areas

Growing system: cordon spur and Guyot

Density: 5.000/5.700 plants per Ha.

Yield per Ha.: 7,5 T/Ha. grapes

Production process: stems removal and soft pressing. Fermentation in stainless steel tanks at controlled temperature and refinement in epoxy resin-lined cement tanks.
